- 1) The student is required to come at least 10 minutes before the beginning of the practical exercise in order to prepare for practical exercises.
- 2) The student is required to attend practical exercises in

clean, white working clothes and shoes. If she/he does not do so, she/he will be excluded from practicing with the necessity of substitution.

3) The use of mobile phone and other similar devices is prohibited in practical exercises. If a student breaks the rule, she/he will be excluded from practicing with the necessity of substitution.

4) If a student violates educational or ethical rules, he/she will be excluded from the practical exercise with the necessity of substitutions.

5) The student can miss only 1/3 of the compulsory education - with the necessity of apology to the teacher and substitution of the missed practical/seminar.

- 10 % of the allowed absence without apology and substitution applies only to subjects where the practical training contains 10 or more practical exercises / seminars. However, it is recommended to apologize to the teacher in person / by email.

6) If the student does not have sufficient knowledge in the practical exercise, it will be excluded from the practical exercise with the necessity of substitution
