Anotace předmětu:

The course is focused on mastering the writing process (pre-writing, writing, re-writing), revising, editing, proof-reading, evaluating arguments, structuring a text, plagiarism and academic integrity (referencing). It includes a part where the theoretical principles are dealt with in practice, such as distinguishing between individual parts of a paper, paragraphing and identifying the most common mistakes on given sample texts. The course is intended to establish knowledge of research writing standards required by most publishers.
