



**Surgical Clinical Experience following the 8th semester of General Medicine**

Student may perform the clinical experience upon successful termination of the examination, where the student demonstrates basic knowledge in surgical propaedeutics, general traumatology and the acute abdomen. During the clinical experience, the student will be introduced to procedures performed at the surgical ambulatory tract (simple procedures- sutures, excisions, centesis, etc., as well as working with documentation- ambulatory chart, clinical record, examination slips), at the plaster room (technique of applying and removing casts), work at the surgical ward (working with the patient charts, rounds, writing up clinical records) as well as work in the operating room (preparation of patient and staff for operation, assisting in certain procedures, etc.).

The work activity and ability of the student will be evaluated at the end of the clinical experience by the head of the department or his assistant according to the following table:
